Ceres Highland Games Terms and Conditions for Stall Holders

The site available for stalls at Ceres Highland Games has some unique limitations which stall-holders should be aware of. The site is a private road, which requires access for emergency vehicles in the event of an emergency. The site also adjoins residential homes, and we request that stall-holders respect the residents' rights in regard to access, privacy, noise, litter and pollution etc.

1. These Terms and Conditions and all other directions given by Ceres Highland Games officials must be followed.
2. Ceres Highland Games takes no responsibility for damage to or loss of stall-holders' property while at or in transit to/from the Games site.
3. Ceres Highland Games recommends that stall-holders take out adequate insurance cover for goods. We cannot provide, and can accept no responsibility for, secure storage space for stallholders. Any goods left unattended on the stall before, during, or after the Games are left at the owner's risk.
4. All stallholders are required by law to hold valid and up to date Public Liability Insurance to insure against injury or damage to any party caused by the stallholder having a stall on site. Ceres Highland Games insurers will not cover ANY stallholder's responsibility.
5. Ceres Highland Games cannot undertake to provide any form of equipment.
6. Stall-holders must not sell, or allow, any alcohol to be sold from their stall.
7. Stall-holders must ensure that all of their units and equipment used and/or licensed by them must comply with all relevant health and safety, and environmental health regulation. Ceres Highland Games reserves the right to exclude any item or person from the event where it is felt that they do not meet current statutory requirements.
8. All Stall-holders are responsible for the collection of rubbish from their stall and its disposal to a designated area.
9. Stalls must be set up before 10:00am on Games Day. Stalls can only be broken down after the Games have finished or when asked to by a Ceres Highland Games official. It is essential that stallholders have the facility to break down stalls quickly in the event of an emergency.
10. Ceres Highland Games reserve the right to allocate stalls as they wish. Your space is only guaranteed once you have received written confirmation from Ceres Highland Games and your payment has cleared in our account.
11. There is no electricity supply on site, and stall-holders may not use generators.
12. All stalls must comply with the dimensions agreed to in the application form.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT A VISIT TO THE SITE PRIOR TO YOUR APPLICATION IS NECESSARY TO UNDERSTAND THE NEED FOR KEEPING WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED STALL MEASUREMENTS AND FOR ACCESS/EGRESS ON SITE, ESPECIALLY IN CASE OF AN EMERGENCY.
